# Features of the Pedestrian & Bicycle Trails



- 9,000 linear feet of DG trails
- 10 feet wide, designed to AASHTO & ADA Standards
- Landscaping along trail
- Lighted bollards every 100 feet

- Site furniture: benches, trash cans, bicycle racks, picnic tables
- Pedestrian bridges over washes
- 2 bike rest stops: drinking fountains, bike racks, seating, covered ramada
