The Avondale Park and Ride opened in 2013 and included 3 bike lockers. The safety and security of our riders remains an important component of our transit program. We currently have solar lighting at this location and promote safety and crime reduction strategies throughout the City. Since opening, there are reported incidents of vandalization of the bike lockers and individuals struggling with homelessness using the lockers. We would like to install security cameras at the Avondale Park and Ride to monitor the site. In addition, we would like to place solar lighting at several high traffic bus stops where individuals struggling

with homelessness have a propensity to use as shelter. This will provide a heightened level of safety for law enforcement and human service providers actively engaging individuals in need of services and as well as provide an additional safety measure for riders utilizing services in the early morning and late evening hours.
