2. When are the applications due to MAG?

The PM-10 Certified Street Sweeper, the PM-10 Pave Unpaved Roads, Pinal County Arterial-Bridge Program and Avondale-Goodyear Urbanized Area Transit applications are due **Thursday, September 10, 2020 at 10:00 am.**

The Road Safety Program and Non Infrastructure Safe Routes to School applications are due **Thursday, October 1, 2020 at 10:00 am.**

3. Can Road Safety Program funding be used for both construction and design?

Road Safety Program funding may only be used for reimbursement to the member agencies for construction of safety improvement projects.

4. What is the member agency match for Road Safety Program projects?

The member match constitutes 10% of the total cost of the project. The costs incurred in designing the project can be counted towards the match requirement. In other words, Design costs can be committed as local funds in lieu of local match.

5. How are Road Safety Program projects selected for funding?

Roadway Safety Program projects are selected on a competitive basis with requests often greatly exceeding available funding. Projects are selected based solely on a weighted value of the following measures:

- a. Cost-Benefit ratio (must be  $\geq 1$ ) using worksheets included in the application
- b. Crash Rate calculated using worksheets included in the application
- c. Presentation Score based on evaluation by Transportation Safety Committee members
