SUBJECT: MAG SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS PLAN: CALL FOR PROJECT OVERVIEWS FUNDING YEARS FY2020, 2021, 2022

On August 26, 2018, the MAG Regional Council approved the Systems Management and Operations Plan (SM&O), allocating approximately \$80 million of regional sub-allocated federal aid to specific project areas for phase I of the plan. At this time, MAG is requesting project overviews from agencies identified in the SM&O plan classified as non-competitive. **The due date for project overviews is on or before 10:00 a.m., April 22, 2019** for consideration of federal aid programming in federal fiscal year (FFY2020). Additional years of programming will be considered as project overviews are submitted.
