The Goodyear Park and Ride opened in December 2010 and included a set of 8 bicycle lockers. In May 2016, the lockers were vandalized. Several months after the locker was repaired, homeless people began using the lockers for shelter so City staff secured the lockers. They have been shut down since. We want to replace them with BikeLids, a product that is in use in Mesa and in Chandler and has been very effective keeping bicycles safe and are homeless-proof. BikeLids allow first come/first served single use while patrons utilize their own standard bicycle lock. This eliminates the need of a separate key and lock mechanism while still providing the security of covered storage, discouraging misuse and optimizing proper use. Furthermore, the unique design has been demonstrated to increase awareness and consideration of bicycle use.
