
Dear Mr. Simmonds,

As co-chairs of the newly established Maricopa Association of Government (MAG) Managed Services Proposal Study Committee, we are requesting a copy of CenturyLink's managed services proposal for regional review. On Wednesday, September 14, 2016, the MAG Management Committee, comprising city/town/county/tribal managers, unanimously approved the formation of the study committee. The MAG Region has a regional 9-1-1 system that was created in 1985 by the MAG member agencies. Our preference is to review CenturyLink's proposal as a region.
