## PROJECT BENEFITS

- This project made significant ADA improvements to two bus stops on Pecos Road at 51st Avenue in Komatke, AZ (District 6, Gila River Indian Community). The stops are served by West End Shuttle, operated by the Gila River Indian Community and Route 51, operated by Valley Metro.
- The improvements provide needed shelter and amenities at the bus stops as well as ADA sidewalk access to the Komatke Health Clinic, Komatke Store, Pecos Road Elder Housing Complex, the Gila River Indian Community Court West End Judicial Center, and the Gila Crossing Community School.
