
Fast Facts



UP Arizona Projects - Update

- **Double Track**

- Work continues in Pinal County, 70% percent completion

- **Red Rock**

- Continued desired to secure AZ State Land for project, although no current construction date

- **Buckeye**

- Rail yard project on hold until economy rebounds
- Customer Growth

- **Growing opportunities with Mexican business**

- Rio Rico investment to support CBP
- Potential for more infrastructure on Nogales Sub, need for extended hours

Other Topics for discussion

- **Intercity Rail (PHX- TUC)**

- UP participating in discussions with ADOT
- There are many challenges to adding passenger trains on current UP infrastructure.

- **Wellton Branch line**

- No current plans for rehabilitation, line is not available for sale.

- **Naco line**

- Currently seeking STB approval for purchase
- Goal to preserve ROW, generational project not intended as by-pass
