

HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE FACT SHEET

WHO will be most affected by the new Marketplace?

- Approximately 1,000,000 Arizona residents without health insurance
- Arizonans with disabilities who are awaiting Medicare coverage
- 4,000 plus Arizona residents currently enrolled in the federal pre-existing condition plan (PCIP)
- Young adults under age 26 with ongoing ability to stay on their parents' health plan

WHAT will the new Marketplace offer Arizonans?

- Affordable health insurance for U.S. Citizens and legal residents who are not eligible for AHCCCS
- No pre-existing conditions exclusions or increased premiums
- Premium subsidies for individuals and families whose income is less than 400% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Reduced cost-sharing limits for individuals and families with income less than 250% of the Federal Poverty Level

WHEN will the new Marketplace be available to Arizonans?

- On October 1, 2013 Arizonans can begin enrolling into the Health Insurance Marketplace – ***new health insurance coverage will begin on January 1, 2014***
- The open-enrollment period will continue through March 31, 2014
