3. **FY 2021 MAG Design Assistance Project Priority List of Projects**

The FY 2020-2021 MAG Unified Planning Work Program and Annual Budget, approved by the MAG Regional Council in May 2019, includes \$500,000 for the MAG Design Assistance Program. A call for projects was made on May 7, 2020. Seventeen applications were successfully submitted by the deadline of July 10, 2020. MAG staff will present the priority list of FY 2021 Design Assistance project applications, as ranked by the committee, for review and recommendation for approval.

4. **Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) Review of MAG Bicycle Count Locations**

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has funded a technical assistance task for the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) for agencies that request help related to non-motorized data for safety assessments. MAG has asked that

TTI assist in developing an assessment of non-motorized data needs and data collection plan for the MAG region. The scope of the agreement between MAG and TTI includes:

- Review and recommendation of count location, count duration and count frequency that would allow for applying a scalable risk assessment guidance;
- Assist with practices MAG should be using to identify location “types” for future data collection efforts; and,
- Recommend elements MAG can focus on for a more pro-active assessment of high-risk areas.

Over the last year, Active Transportation Committee members submitted candidate count locations for consideration. TTI will provide a high-level overview of these locations based on scalable risk assessment guidance. The locations submitted by members will be made part of the count project, however, additional locations may also be included as a result of TTI’s analysis and member input.
