AMENDING SECTION 41-5001, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VALID IDENTIFICATION.

6 A. This state or any political subdivision of this state shall ~~not~~
7 accept a consular identification card that is issued by a foreign
8 government as a valid form of identification IF THE FOREIGN GOVERNMENT
9 USES BIOMETRIC IDENTITY VERIFICATION TECHNIQUES IN ISSUING THE CONSULAR
10 IDENTIFICATION CARD.

11 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "BIOMETRIC IDENTITY
12 VERIFICATION TECHNIQUES" INCLUDES FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION AND RETINA
13 SCANS.
