“ prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, and national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance.”



# **Environmental Justice Executive Order**

- Used latest population numbers from the US Census and the American Community Survey (ACS) data for the period of 2014-2018









Title VI Program Responsibilities
