SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2021 MAG TRAFFIC SIGNAL OPTIMIZATION PROGRAM REQUEST FOR PROJECT APPLICATIONS

Member agencies are invited to submit candidate projects for inclusion in the FY2021 Traffic Signal Optimization Program (TSOP). Project applications must be submitted via email to: Eric Nava enava@azmag.gov by **noon on Friday, October 26, 2020**. **Late applications will not be accepted.**

A member agency may submit one or more projects of a regional scale, involving two or more agencies, and one single-agency project. Each TSOP project may cost up to \$80,000. These projects would not require matching local funds. A total of \$420,933 is available for FY2020 TSOP projects. Fifteen local traffic engineering consulting firms, under contract with MAG to provide on-call consulting services, will provide technical assistance for the selected projects.

Please submit an application for each of your candidate projects, using the project application form provided with this letter (Attachment 1). A description of project types, project review process and agency responsibilities is provided (Attachment 2). Additional information is provided as a Q & A document (Attachment 3).
