SUBJECT: PROJECT APPLICATIONS FOR MAG FEDERAL FUNDS

Applications for PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers in FY 2011 and PM-10 Pave Unpaved Road projects in FY 2014 are now available for the competitive selection process for MAG Federal Funds for inclusion in the FY 2011-2015 MAG Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). There will not be a competitive project selection process for arterial ITS, bicycle, and pedestrian projects in FY 2011; all funds directed to arterial ITS, bicycle and pedestrian projects in 2011-2014 are fully programmed in the FY 2011-2015 MAG TIP.

The applications for PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers and PM-10 Pave Unpaved are provided as Microsoft Excel workbooks and it is requested that applicants complete these workbooks with the required information. It is required that excel applications are submitted both electronically via e-mail and in a printed hard copy format with the necessary signatures is submitted to MAG by the due date. The applications may be downloaded from the MAG website under the Transportation area, on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) webpage: <http://www.mag.maricopa.gov/project.cms?item=413>. In addition, printed copies of all applications, background memorandums, and application resources are enclosed with this memorandum.

As outlined in the fiscal year (FY) 2011 MAG Transportation Programming Guidebook, available federal funds to be programmed through the MAG competitive selection process for inclusion in the 2011-2015 MAG TIP are:

- PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers in FY 2011- \$900,000 federal CMAQ funds
- PM-10 Pave Unpaved Road projects in FY 2014- \$4,898,000, federal CMAQ funds

There will be a workshop held on Tuesday, August 17, 2010, 11:00 a.m. - 12:00/noon at MAG Office, Suite 200 – Saguaro Room, 302 North 1st Avenue, Phoenix, to discuss and explain the FY 2011 Project Applications for PM-10 Certified Street Sweepers and PM-10 Pave Unpaved Roads.
