
CONNECTING TALENT WITH COMMUNITY

Levels of Matching

Executive/Encore Fellowships: paid or stipend positions requiring a high level of screening, training, & time commitment

Service By Design: unpaid or stipend positions requiring mid-level training, skills, & position commitment

Mainstay: volunteer opportunities with limited commitment & training required




