Development of the FY 2006-2010 Draft MAG TIP

Federal Requirements for the TIP:

- **What should be in the TIP? :**
 - All Title 23 Federally funded projects;
 - All regionally significant projects.

- **How often? :**
 - Every Two Years

- **What details are needed? :**
 - Sufficient detail (design concept and scope) to permit air quality analysis in accordance with the U.S. conformity requirements





Development of the FY 2006-2010 Draft MAG TIP

The Process is as follows:

- All projects come from the 04-07 TIP and RTP;
- MAG Federally Funded projects by Dec;
- ADOT and Transit projects are added by Dec;
- Agency projects by the end of January;
- Draft TIP for a conformity analysis by April;
- Conformity analysis complete by May/June;
- Regional Council approval of TIP in July;
- Federal approval of AQCA by Jul/Aug;
- Governor's designee's approval in Aug/Sept;
- Incorporation into the STIP in Sep/Oct.


What projects are listed ?

- **The projects listed are as follows:**
 - Over 500 street projects;
 - Over 250 transit projects;
 - Over 140 freeway projects;
 - 100 bicycle and pedestrian projects;
 - Almost 60 ITS projects;
 - Over 30 AQ or TDM projects;
 - Over 30 other projects
 - ***Over 1100 total projects***

Source of Total Funds in the FY 2006-2010 Draft MAG TIP (millions of \$)




Total: \$5.649 Billion Total Dollars

Funding Allocation by Mode in the FY 2006-2010 Draft MAG TIP (millions of \$)


