

## Types of Spyware

Browser Hijack	Programs that take control of your web browser and use it to show you unsolicited advertisements or worse.
Adware	Software that monitors your online activities for Pop-Up advertising or for other targeted marketing purposes.
Trojans	Dangerous programs that make your computer vulnerable to being remotely controlled or accessed by hackers.
Profiling Cookies	Small data files placed on your computer to track your web surfing habits.
Keyboard Loggers and Trackware	Programs that capture and record your every keystroke, including personal information and passwords.
Dialers	Programs that can auto-dial 900 or toll calls without your permission.
Droneware	Programs that take control of your PC, often to send spam or to host offense web images.
Web Bugs	A graphics on a Web page or in an Email message that is designed to monitor who is reading the Web page or Email message. Web Bugs are often invisible because they are typically only 1-by-1 pixel in size. They are represented as HTML IMG tags. The Internet advertising community prefers the sanitized term "clear GIF". Web Bugs are also known as "1-by-1 GIFs" and "invisible GIFs".
